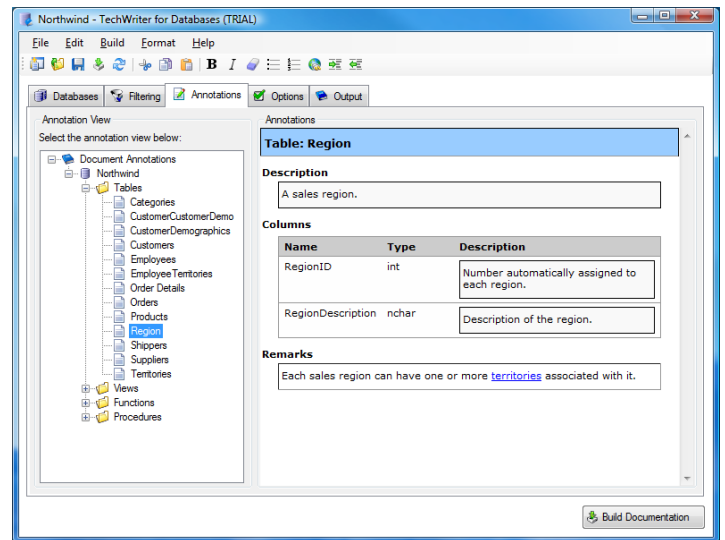

Documentation Generation

Advanced Filtering

- Explicitly filter specific topics from the documentation through a checkbox interface.
- Filter based on wildcard patterns that match item names.

Annotations

- WYSIWYG annotation editor for adding and revising item descriptions and remarks.
- Rich content model that supports formatting of paragraphs, lists, tables, images, hyperlinks and more.
- Import/Export annotations to/from comma-delimited and XML files.
- Export annotations to a SQL script (Database edition).

Customization

- Custom Language File allows over 100 alternate values for output headings and text. Can be used to support other languages or produce highly customized output.
- Over 30 options for controlling what details are included in the documentation.

Command Line Interface

- Can be called from build tools (e.g. MSBuild, Ant, NAnt)
- Parameters include project file, output type and refresh switch.
